Note that for Charters summary excludes the Damar, Excel and the Options. With those four excluded, you can now say over half of Charters are C or better (couldn't on Wed).

Note that the total number from Wed to Friday for all schools changes because I clipped off about 40 schools in my haste to push out spread sheet on Wed.
